

SCOTT COUNTY FAMILY Y Family Camping at YMCA Camp Abe Lincoln Cabin Rules

This document contains the general rules which apply to all cabins at YMCA Camp Abe Lincoln

Rules for All Cabins

- 1. Regular occupancy is the number of people that can be accommodated for the beds available in the cabin. Maximum occupancy is the absolute number of people allowed to stay in a cabin. If the number of occupants is greater than the regular occupancy, the renter is responsible for providing sleeping accommodations for the additional occupants.
- 2. Renters must provide their own bedding, pillows, towels, toiletry items, dishes and some cleaning items such as paper towels, dish soap, etc.
- 3. Check-in time is 6:00 p.m. on Fridays. Check-out time is 11:00 a.m. on Sundays. Smoking is not allowed in the cabins.
- 4. The Scott County Family YMCA and YMCA Camp Abe Lincoln is not responsible for personal items that are lost, stolen, or become damaged.
- 5. Do not burn trash in fireplaces or fire rings. All interior cabin furniture must remain inside the cabin. Use hot pads under dishes on all counters and tables. Creating or sustaining any unreasonable noise in any portion of the cabin/yurt area or campground.
- 6. Remove all personal items and food from the cabin at the end of your stay. Please do not leave items for the next renter to use.
- 7. Cabins have been designated as pet-free.
